



Primary STEAM Teacher Job Description

We currently have opportunities for energetic, experienced Primary Teachers who are available on an adhoc supply basis to deliver Teacher CPD Courses and Primary Workshops to support schools in providing enriching STEAM learning experiences for their students.

The Opportunity

CREATE Education already deliver 3D printing and CAD CPD workshops to teachers across the UK and Ireland. In 2019 we are looking to expand our offering to deliver more of these as well as introduce a new service delivering 3D printing and STEAM workshops directly to groups of up to 30 Primary School students.

The teacher CPD and student workshops are available as full day or half day sessions and are all fully planned, prepared and resourced by the CREATE Education Team.

We are looking for engaging and enthusiastic qualified teachers to deliver the CPD and student workshops throughout the UK and Ireland on an adhoc basis as bookings are made. The courses and workshops will be marketed extensively through CREATE Education, but you will also be provided with marketing materials in order to market the workshops locally if you wish to gain more bookings and sales commission in your area.

Remuneration

Successful applicants will be remunerated at the following rates:

- £100 plus mileage expenses for delivering a half day (3hr) workshop
- £200 plus mileage expenses for delivering a full day workshop

In addition to this you will be eligible to receive commission for any CPD, workshop or equipment sales that you make at the following rates:

- £25 for a half day CPD or workshop
- £50 for a full day CPD or workshop
- 5% for any 3D printer/hardware sales

Requirements

Applicants must have:

- Teaching experience in the primary sector (ages 4-11).
- Expertise (or interest) in STEAM and Computing subject areas.
- Good ICT skills with the ability to quickly learn new software.
- A passion for learning and embracing new technologies.
- Excellent communication skills with the ability to liaise directly with school leaders, teachers and support staff.
- Excellent classroom management skills.
- 2 days available (expenses paid) to attend training in Chorley, Lancashire.
- Their own laptop computer.
- Their own vehicle as they will need to transport equipment and resources for delivering the workshops.

Responsibilities

Applicants will be expected to:

- Be a representative of the CREATE Education Project, reflecting our ethos and values at all times when dealing with schools, educators and students.
- Liaise directly with schools and organisations who have booked a workshop to make the required arrangements for the workshop delivery and support schools in preparing for it.
- Arrive in plenty of time to meet school staff, set-up and be ready to deliver the workshop at the agreed start time.

- Deliver the CPD and workshops in the format developed by CREATE Education Team using the resources provided in order to provide a consistent experience to all customers.
- Modify teaching styles where required to fit the learning styles of various students.
- Maintain a well-managed classroom and positive learning environment.
- Inspire, enthuse and support all participants to deliver high quality learning experiences for all.
- Gather formal feedback (documents provided) from all participants at the end of each workshop.
- Provide feedback to the CREATE Education Project after each workshop and where appropriate input ideas for improvements and/or new workshops to inform future development of our offering.
